PHASE 3 BOWLING PROTOCOL

COVID Phase 3 Bowling Protocol is in effect from Monday June 21, 2021, until further notice.

Registered Members of Juan de Fuca Lawn Bowls Club for 2021 can now bowl daily on a drop-in basis, scheduling is no longer required.

The new **Protocols** are now in effect, however, they are subject to change in accordance with any announcements made by the Provincial Health Authority, ViaSport and Bowl BC. You will be advised of any changes.

- Bowling will be available daily from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Individual Practice, Singles, Pairs, Triples and Crown bowling are permitted. It will be necessary to arrange your own games.
- Self monitoring is in effect as no designated Monitors will be assigned except during League Play and Organized Events. Contact Julie Dickson or Gary Paugh at 250-478-0084 if you have questions.
- Bowlers must sanitize upon arrival at the club and before leaving. Sanitizing spray bottles are available in the Equipment room.
- Keys for the Equipment Room, Locker Room and Clubhouse are kept in the Lock Box hanging on the Equipment Room door. The code is **2018**.
- When unlocking the Clubhouse, you must do so by the door next to the office as the **alarm keypad** is located inside the door to your right. The alarm system is normally already disarmed by the Westshore staff but if the alarm is buzzing it needs to be shut off, enter the code **6122** on the keypad.
- Symptoms Screening Questionnaires (SSQ) MUST be completed on each visit prior to bowling and left in the file folder labeled CURRENT. The file folder will be located on the shelf in the Equipment Room. When an individual's SSQ is full, you are responsible for bringing a new form. You cannot bowl if you do not complete this form (extras are in the Red folder located in the Monitor's box).
- Bowlers **MUST CHECK THEIR NAME OFF** on the **ROSTER** sheet for the date they are in attendance. The dated Roster sheet will be attached to the inside of the Equipment Room door and is required for Contact Tracing.
- Bowling is on designated open greens, check the sign in the Clubhouse Office window for the daily open greens. Bowling in the **Morning** and **Evening** is **East/West** (Clubhouse) and **Afternoon** is **North/South** (Arena)
- All equipment is to be returned to the equipment shed after use. NO equipment is to be removed from the
 premises with the exception of bowls. Bowls may be signed out by completing the Sign Out sheet located in the
 back of the CURRENT folder.
- Washrooms are available in the Clubhouse and Public washrooms are located at the far end of the building.
- Masks MUST be worn in the Clubhouse. Maximum 26 persons in the Clubhouse, 1 person limit in the washroom is no longer in effect.
- Equipment shed, Locker Room and Clubhouse MUST be locked prior to leaving the club.

These COVID 19 Protocols remain in effect at all times when attending the premises.

- Wash or sanitize hands on arrival at and before departing the club.
- Maintain 2-meter distancing.
- Limit of 1 person in the equipment shed at any given time.
- Your signed **Participant Agreement** continues to apply.
- Your signed Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to COVID-19 continues to apply.
