

Juan de Fuca Men's Pairs. Starts May 18.

Players may want to contact their partners and let Gary Paugh know if practice is planned before the start of play. The seasons schedule and rink assignments will follow next week. If you have not been to the club and played already this season, you will have some paperwork to fill out.

Welcome all. These weekly events are intended to be viewed as practice and training sessions. Although records will be kept and results will be published, there is no entry fee, and no prizes will be awarded. These days should be fun and give everyone a chance to improve skills and strategy.

For the purposes of contact tracing, you must initial the Attendance Calendar located on the inside of the Equipment Room door. Please check the attached players list to make sure your current telephone number is accurate. If corrections are required, please contact me ASAP so changes can be made.

Team pairings have been selected at random.

#### Conditions of play

To facilitate safe play and social distancing, players should remember to keep a safe distance and to refrain from touching the equipment used by other players. It may not be possible for mats and jacks or rakes to be touched by only one person so use the hand sanitizing station frequently.

1. Teams will be made up of two men either of whom could be Skip on any day.
2. This is a round robin event. Each team will play every other team.
3. A coin toss will determine the home team and that team can choose to play first or give up the mat.
4. The Home team will be the scorekeeper for the match. Please record the date, players names and team number and rink assignments on each scorecard.
5. Mat placement is to be a minimum 3 meters from the ditch.
6. The first two ends will only score one point.
7. Keep to the left when changing ends.
8. Jacks may be thrown.
9. Or it is permissible to play with two jacks placed with feet by skips.
10. The game will be played with four bowls per player and be 14 ends in duration.
11. Balls in the ditch may be moved to an area that is out of play unless they are touchers.
12. Jacks knocked out of play are to be placed on the 2-metre mark.
13. Measuring is permissible. If a point decision cannot be agreed upon, ask a neighbouring rink.
14. The 2-meter social distancing is not applicable on the Greens, only when you are off.
