

## JDF LBC BOWLING PROTOCOL

The Juan de Fuca Lawn Bowls Club Bowling Protocol is in effect from April 16, 2022, until further notice.

Registered Members of **Juan de Fuca Lawn Bowls Club** for 2022 season can now bowl daily on a drop-in basis. Note that schedule Leagues, Tournaments and events will have priority for rink assignments.

The new **Protocols** are subject to change in accordance with any announcements made by the Provincial Health Authority, ViaSport and Bowl BC. You will be advised of any changes.

- Bowling will be available daily from **10:00 a.m.**
- Individual Practice, Singles, Pairs, Triples and Crown bowling are permitted. You may participate in leagues, events, tournaments or organize your own games/practice sessions.
- Bowling is permitted on **designated open greens**, check the sign in the Clubhouse Office window for the daily open greens. Bowling in the **Morning** and **Evening** is **East/West** (Clubhouse) and **Afternoon** is **North/South** (Arena).
- Keys for the Equipment Room, Locker Room and Clubhouse are kept in the **Lock Box** hanging on the Equipment Room door. The code is **9111**. Always return the keys, close lock box and spin dials.
- Unlocking the Clubhouse, you must do so by the door next to the office as the **alarm keypad** is located inside the door to your right. The alarm system is normally already disarmed by the Westshore staff but if the alarm sounding it needs to be shut off, enter the code **6122** on the keypad.
- All equipment is to be returned to the equipment shed or locker room after use. **NO equipment or club bowls are to be removed from the Club premises** without prior permission (contact the Executive).
- Equipment shed, Locker Room and Clubhouse **MUST be locked** prior to leaving the club.
- Washrooms are available in the Clubhouse and Public washrooms are located at the far end of the building.

These safety Protocols always remain in effect for attending the premises.

- Stay home if you are sick.
- Cover if you need to cough or sneeze.
- Maintain good hand hygiene, sanitizer bottles are available for your use.
- Wearing a Mask in the Clubhouse and the Locker Room is now optional.
- Adhere to 1 person limit in the equipment shed.

Safe Sport participation helps ensure an environment that is accessible, inclusive, respectful, and safe.

- Sign the Members Pledge, included with your Registration.
- Act in accordance with the Club's Code of Conduct at all times.
- Report to the Club's Safety Officer any issues related to safety or occurrences of maltreatment.
