

Tuesday Men's Triple League

Conditions of play

- Teams will be made up of three men either of whom could be Skip or Vice or Lead on any day.
- Teams will be formed from those persons who register to play. Registration can be by signup at the club, or by email, or text to the coordinator. Team formation will follow a blind draw format. Skips will draw for vice and lead from a pool of registered men players.
- This is a round robin event. Depending on the number of teams and the number of weeks available, each team will play every other team at least once and perhaps twice. If weeks are missed due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, games may be made up at the end of the season.
- The winner of a coin toss will determine the home team and that team can choose to play first or give up the mat.
- The home team will be the scorekeeper for the match. Please record the date, players names, team number and rink assignments on each scorecard.
- Mat placement is to be a minimum 3 meters from the ditch.
- The first two ends will only score one point.
- Keep to the left when changing ends.
- The game will be played with three bowls per player and be 14 ends in duration.
- Balls in the ditch may be moved to an area that is out of play unless they are touchers.
- Jacks knocked out of play are to be placed on the 2 metre mark.
- If a point decision cannot be agreed upon, ask a neighbouring rink.
- Please contact the coordinator if further clarification is required.
