

## BSI – GREENSLADE MEN'S TRIPLES AUGUST 15 & 16, 2023

**Updated 2023-07-13 with revised Conditions of Play** 

**Location:** Oak Bay Lawn Bowling Club, 2190 Harlow Drive, Victoria

<u>Entries:</u> Open format, teams of three men can be formed from different clubs. <u>One</u> <u>member must be a novice or intermediate player</u> which is a member who has joined a lawn bowling club in April of 2020 or later. The reason for 2020 is due to COVID so we have joined 2020 and 2021 years together and counted them as one.

**Fee:** \$75 per team. Pre-payment not required.

**Format:** Three 16-end games on Tuesday and two 16-end games on Wednesday. Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark 4<sup>th</sup> Edition 2022 apply. Bell start and finish with a 2.25 hour time limit.

**Dress:** Players must be in matching uniforms, but not red which is for Umpires

**Start Time:** Games start at 9:00 am each day.

**<u>Prizes:</u>** Determined by the number of teams that enter.

**Registration:** Opens July 17, 2023 and closes August 11

**50/50:** Tickets will be available on both days at a cost of \$5 for three tickets or \$10 for ten tickets.

Tea/Coffee/Sweets/Chips and Goodies: Cost is \$3 each day.

**Optional Draw:** Teams can pay \$15 and have their team's name placed on a board. At each break, up to two team names will be drawn and removed from the list. At the end of the tournament, the last team whose name is still on the board will win the entire prize money.

Format: Upon arrival, Skips will pick their team number via a random draw.

## Conditions of Play

- 1. Games will start at 9, 12, and 2:45 on Tuesday and 9 and 12 on Wednesday.
- 2. Match scoring: 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 for a loss.
- 3. First two ends of each game score a maximum of 1 point. (No trial ends.)
- 4. A maximum allowable point differential (For-Ag) per game is set at 15. (Winner's score will be reduced to Loser's score +15.)
- 5. Ranking will be by total match points; if tied, then shot differential (For-Ag); if still tied, then shot aggregate %(For/Ag); if still tied, by ends won; and if still tied, a one-end game with each player using two bowls.
- 6. Burnt ends: Place jack at the intersection of the two-metre line and the centre line.
- 7. Lead can visit the head after their third bowl, the Vice after their second bowl, and the skip after the first bowl.
- 8. Substitutions are permitted due to illness or other unforeseen events. Those substituting must play lead.
