## JOAN PRICE QUADDIE CONDITIONS OF PLAY JULY 16, 2024

1. Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark 4th Edition, 2022 including all appendixes, unless specified in these Conditions of Play.
2. General Rules Governing Competitions and Open Tournaments, published in the BSI Women's Games Book, shall also apply.
3. OPEN Tournament - members of each team do not have to be from the same BSI club.
4. Dress Code - Players' shirts and pants may be in any colour, with the exception of red which is reserved for the umpires. All members of the team are to be attired in the same colours.
5. Smoking: There will be no smoking anywhere within the bounds of the West Shore Parks and Recreation, including no smoking of electronic cigarettes.

## 6. Game Format:

- games will be 16 ends with the exception of singles which will be played to 15 points and/or 1.5 hours.
- Random Draw
- Round 1-2 pairs games of $21 / 2$ hours duration
- Round 2-1 Triples game of $21 / 2$ hours duration and

1 Singles game to 15 points and/or 1.5 hours

- Round 3-1 Fours game of $21 / 2$ hours duration.
- There will be a 9am Bell Start for Round 1-2 pairs games.
- The start time for all other games is at the discretion of the coordinator.

7. No trial ends - First two ends maximum shots awarded one per end,
8. Burnt ends will be reset at the 2 metre mark.
9. Scoring: Three points are awarded for a win, one for a tie and 0 for a loss. Winners will be decided by total points after all games have been played. Shots
for divided by shots against will be used if points are the same. If still tied, the number of ends won will be considered. Please enter ends won on all scorecards.
10. Shot differential will be capped at 15 points.

## 11. Visitations to the Head:

SINGLES GAME: the opponents, after delivery of their $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ bowls. In exceptional and limited circumstances, a singles player may ask the marker for permission to walk up to the head.

PAIRS GAME: the Leads after delivery of their $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ bowls; and the Skips, after the delivery of their $2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ bowls.

TRIPLES GAME: the Leads, after delivery of their $3^{\text {rd }}$ bowl; the Seconds after delivery of their $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ bowls; and the Skips, after the delivery of each of their bowls.

FOURS GAME: the Leads, after the second player in their team has delivered their 2nd bowl; the Seconds, after delivery of their 2nd bowl; the Vices, after delivery of their $2^{\text {nd }}$ bowl; and the Skips after delivery of each of their bowls.
