Play starts early in May and goes into September. The first half of our season will be games of Triples, and the second half will be games of Pairs.

Scores are tallied individually, and playoffs are held at the end of each session for both Triples and Doubles. Playoff contenders will be those who have the highest scores after playing in a set number of games during each half of the season.
